The following are guidelines for registering for Classroom Driver's Training Classes (CDT):

Reminder: a student must pass 8 classes in two consecutive semesters to be eligible for CDT and PDT. If in junior high, then at least 4 of the 5 academic classes (Literature, Language, Math, Science, Social Studies) MUST BE PASSED. PDT enrollment will be based on passing CDT and remaining academically eligible.

If the student will be 15 by **October 18th**, can enroll in CDT 1 If the student will be 15 by **December 22nd**, can enroll in CDT 2 If the student will be 15 by **March 11th**, can enroll in CDT 3 If the student will be 15 by **May 22th**, can enroll in CDT 4
